

ORDINANCE NO. 7677-29

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING ELECTION  
JUDGES FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION  
ON THE QUESTION OF INCREASING THE  
ANNUAL LIBRARY TAX FOR MAINTENANCE  
AND OPERATION

---

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously ordained by Ordinance No. 7576-97, which was passed on April 26, 1976, and approved on April 29, 1976, that a Special election would be held on September 11, 1976, to submit to the voters of the City of Urbana the question of whether the annual library tax for maintenance and operation should be increased from .2364% to .35% of the value of all taxable property in the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously called for that special election by Ordinance No. 7677-15, which was passed on August 2, 1976, and approved on August 4, 1976, and

WHEREAS, certain persons have volunteered to serve without charge as Judges of Election for that special election and now need to be formally appointed to serve as such.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

For the special election previously called by Ordinance No. 7677-15, the following named persons, each of whom is a citizen of the United States and is entitled to vote at the next election; is of good repute and character; is able to speak, read and write the English language; is skilled in the four fundamental rules of arithmetic; is of good understanding and is capable, is not a candidate for election at this election and is not an elected committeeman, are hereby appointed Judges of Election for such election in the precincts shown as follows:
