

ORDINANCE NO. 7677-34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XIV,
SECTION 14-13 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC
ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO SPECIAL PARKING PERMITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 14.13, entitled "Parking Permits", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted on Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance be and the same is hereby amended by revising subsections (a) and (b) and by adding a new subsection (d) as follows:

(a) On each street in the area bounded by (but not including) Green and Race Streets, Lincoln and Florida Avenue (hereinafter called "the area"), parking on that side of the street where parking is not prohibited at all times shall be prohibited between 3:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M., except for those vehicles displaying a valid permit issued pursuant to subsections (b), (c) or (d) below. The foregoing parking prohibitions of this subsection shall not be operative on Saturdays, Sundays, or City legal holidays.

(b) Special parking permits may be issued as follows:


(1) For an entire year the term of which is to commence on August 15th and terminate on August 14th of the following year at a cost of \$100.00 per yearly permit.

(2) For a seven (7) month period the term of which is to commence on January 15th and terminate on August 14th of that same year at a cost of \$60.00 per seven-month permit.

(d) A limited special parking permit may be issued for up to a maximum of three (3) consecutive days by the Urbana Police Department to any applicant who personally applies for such a permit at a cost of \$2.00 per day or a total of \$5.00 for an entire three (3) day period.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 20th day of September, 1976.
