

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is not part of any Fire Protection District, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and all electors residing therein of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

WHEREAS, since the territory herein annexed includes highways under the jurisdiction of Urbana Township and Notice was given to the Auditors of Urbana Township and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said Notice being mailed on the 27th day of October, 1976, and which said Notice stated that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of the City Council on the 15th day of November, 1976, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notice was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County on Octo-
ber 29, 1976,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

Lot 402 in Ennis Ridge Sixteenth Subdivision, and also the full sixty foot right-of-way known and platted as Scovill Street, from the West property line extended, to the East property line extended, of said lot (part of said right-of-way being reannexed); all being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section

Twenty One, Township Nineteen North, Range
Nine East of the Third Principal Meridian,
Champaign County, Illinois.

Commonly known as 1303 East Scovill Street,
Urbana, Illinois.

Illinois.

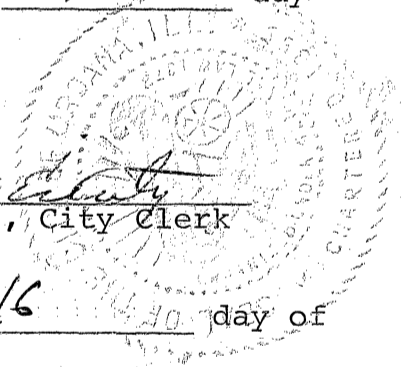
Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and

by law.



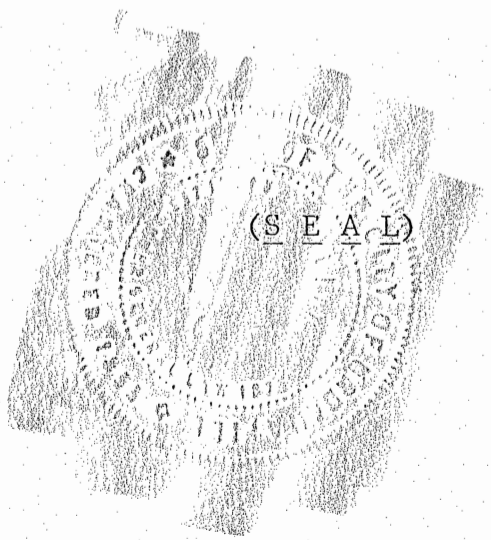

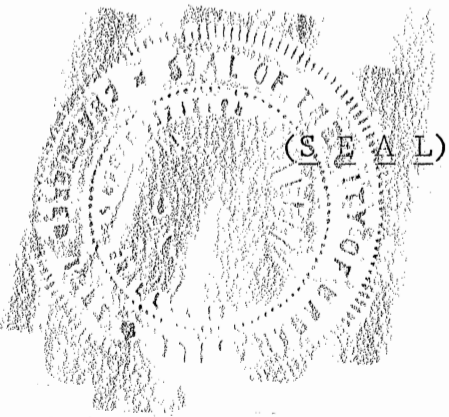
