

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 34.110B OF THE URBANA ZONING ORDINANCE RELATING TO FREE STANDING SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission in Case No. 994, after due notice, held a public hearing on November 4, 1976, on the proposed amendment, and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the Urbana Plan Commission has recommended to the City Council of Urbana, Illinois, that the Urbana Zoning Ordinance, Section 34.110B be amended, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Urbana, Illinois, after due deliberation, finds that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City that Section 34.110B be amended as recommended;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. In Section 34.110B of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance, the following language in the column titled "Location of Sign" be repealed upon the effective date of this ordinance:

"No free standing signs permitted within 100 feet of any residential district, public school, park, hospital or nursing home."

Section 2. That upon the effective date of this ordinance in place of the abovesaid language is herewith and hereby enacted the following words:

"No free standing signs permitted within 100 feet of any residential district where the nearest lot contains a residential dwelling unit, public school, park, hospital or nursing home."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1 - 2 - 4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 6th day of December, 1976.

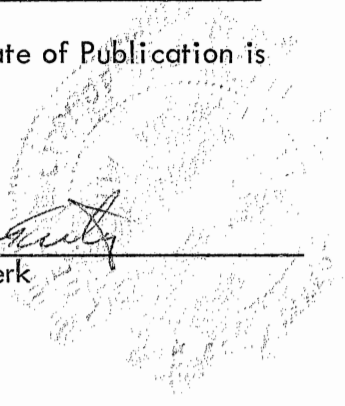
