

ORDINANCE NO. 7677-92

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7576-111

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 22.1, entitled "Purpose and exceptions", of Chapter 22, entitled "Transient Merchants, Itinerant Merchants, Itinerant Vendors, Peddlers, Canvassers, and Solicitors", of the Urbana City Code be and the same is hereby amended:

(1) by deleting therefrom the words "not more than three (3) consecutive days and if no such sale is held on more than two separate occasions" and by substituting therefor the words "no more than seven (7) days", and

(2) by adding to the section, at the conclusion thereof, the following additional exception:

"Nor shall this ordinance be deemed to apply to any person who would otherwise require a license as a transient merchant, itinerant merchant or itinerant vendor, as defined herein, if such person is listed as a person operating under the sponsorship of one who has a license to engage in such business within the City of Urbana."

Section 2. That Section 22.2, entitled "Definitions", of Chapter 22 above-entitled, be and the same is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the present definition of a "garage sale" and by substituting therefor the following definition:

"A 'garage sale' is a sale of used items, goods and wares legally owned by, or on consignment to, the person(s) actually residing on the premises upon which such sale is held."

Section 3. That Section 22.3, entitled "Requirements of eligibility for licenses", of Chapter 22 above-entitled, be and the same is hereby amended by adding to that section, at the conclusion thereof, the following additional requirement for submission:

"I. The name and address of the person or persons, if any, engaged in business as a transient merchant, itinerant merchant or itinerant vendor, as defined herein, operating such business under the sponsorship of the applicant, together with a statement from the applicant undertaking to be responsible for any such person or persons so sponsored for any violation of the provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Urbana and State of Illinois regulating and concerning the sale of goods, wares and merchandise. Such applicant shall later be permitted to add or delete, at any time during the term of such license and without additional fee, any person or persons desired to be so sponsored or removed by notifying the City Clerk in writing and supplying the name and address of the person or persons to be added or deleted."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 18th day of April, 1977.
