WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Philo Fire Protection District, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the said Fire Protection District, said Notice being mailed on June 13, 1977, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 P.M., Tuesday, July 5, 1977, and the Affidavit of mailing such notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and all electors residing therein, of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

The West 512.13 feet of the East 662.13 feet of the South 150 feet of the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois, said tract containing 1.76 acres, subject to the Rights of the Public in the Roads described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 21, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian; thence Northerly along the East line of said Southwest Quarter, 30.00 feet; thence Westerly 150.00 feet for a point of beginning; thence Westerly 512.13 feet; thence Southerly 60.00 feet; thence Easterly, 512.13 feet; thence Northerly, 60.00 feet to the point of commencement, for a total of 2.11 acres more or less.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to


file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.
