ORDINANCE NO. 7778-39

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.22 OF  
THE URBANA CITY CODE TO ESTABLISH NEW FEES  
FOR FIRE PREVENTION PERMITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Part III, entitled "Fire Prevention", of  
Section 18.22, entitled "Schedule of Fees", of Chapter 18,  
entitled "Licenses", of the Urbana City Code, as amended, be  
and the same is hereby further amended as follows to establish  
newly designated fees for permits required by The BOCA Basic  
Fire Prevention Code, 1975, as heretofore duly adopted by the  
City Council:

Any person, firm or corporation required to obtain more than one (1) permit as set forth above to engage, at any specifically defined- single location, in any business activity involving the handling, storage or use of hazardous substances, materials or devices; or to maintain, store or handle materials; or to conduct processes which produce conditions hazardous to life or property, or to install equipment used in connection with such activities, shall only be required to pay for any and all permits so required such maximum fee for that specific location as that set forth for the most expensive permit so required to be obtained. The fee for any second or subsequent permit for any specific location is and will accordingly be waived.

NOTE: Specific provisions for obtaining a fire prevention permit required for the various uses and activities as set forth above are provided in The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code, 1975, as adopted under Chapter 12, Section 12.1 of the Urbana City Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said council on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November, 1977.
