

ORDINANCE NO. 7778-40

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited on Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to that Article the following new and additional Section 14-14, together with a new and additional Schedule XV:

Section 14-14. Parking time limited on certain streets or public parking lots.

A. When signs are erected in each block or in each municipal parking lot giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time in excess of that indicated upon said sign at any time between the hours of 8 a.m. and 9 p.m. of any day except Sundays and those public holidays so designated by the City Council in Section 2.2 of the Urbana City Code, as amended, on any of the streets or public parking lots described in Schedule XV attached to and made a part of this ordinance.

B. Each police officer or parking meter patrol person or assistant shall place securely in a conspicuous location on every vehicle parking in violation of any of the provisions of this section a notice that such vehicle has been so illegally parked and instruct the operator as to the procedure of paying any fine therefor or of contesting the violation.

C. Any person who permits a vehicle to be parked longer than the period of time indicated on said sign as provided in subsection A of this section may, within twenty-four (24) hours of the time when the notice required in subsection B of this section was placed upon such vehicle, pay as the penalty for, and in full satisfaction of such violation, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and within the

next seventy-two (72) hours the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00). The failure of such person to make such payment within seventy-two (72) hours shall render such person subject to the penalties provided in Section 16-1 of this Ordinance.

D. The Mayor is hereby authorized, on the basis of engineering and traffic investigation, to establish, regulate and post appropriate signs indicating the length of the periods of time during which parking shall be allowed under this section.

Schedule XV  
Parking Time Limits

1. Broadway Avenue between Elm Street and Lincoln Square on the west side of the street;  
  
Main Street between Cedar Street and Vine Street on both sides of the street; and  
  
Broadway Avenue between Main Street and Water Street on both sides of the street.
2. Municipal Parking Lots 10A, 10B, 10E, 10F, 3, 7, 8 and 15.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 21st day of November, 1977.
