That Article XII, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Prohibited in Specified Places", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is further amended to add a new Section to be numbered as Section 12-9, and entitled, "Parking in Spots Designated for Handicapped Persons", which shall provide as follows: (a) No person who is not handicapped shall park any vehicle in any parking space which has been designated for a handicapped or disabled person. (b) For the purpose of this section, a handicapped person shall include every natural person whose permanent or temporary condition causes that person to walk with difficulty or insecurity. Section 2. That Section 14-8, entitled "Parking on Private Property", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited on Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by designating the existing paragraph of that section as subsection (a) and by adding new subsections (b) and (c), which shall provide as follows: (b) Any person who is not handicapped, and who parks a motor vehicle in a parking space on private property designated for handicapped or disabled persons, shall be deemed to have parked without the permission of the owner of the private property. (c) For the purpose of this section, a handicapped person shall include every natural person whose permanent or temporary condition causes that person to walk with difficulty or insecurity. Section 3. That Section 14.11, entitled "Towing of Illegally Parked Vehicles", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited on Certain Streets", 1 -

of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by deleting the reference to Section 14-8 contained therein and substituting therefor Section 14-8(a).

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
