ORDINANCE NO. 7879-13

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF CITY COMPTROLLER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

The office of city comptroller is hereby Section 1. established. Annually and whenever vacancies occur in such office, the city comptroller shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council.

Section 2. Until such time as a city comptroller is both duly appointed and approved in accordance with Section 1 of this Ordinance and also commences to perform the duties conferred upon that office by statute or ordinance, all provisions of law relating to the powers and duties of that office shall be performed by such other officers of the City of Urbana as are currently so designated to exercise and perform those powers and duties under the Illinois Municipal Code and the Urbana City Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby passed at a regular meeting of the City Council by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3 rds) of all the aldermen and alderwomen elected who did not abstain from voting on this Ordinance, all in accordance with Section 3-7-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code and with Section 2.6(2) of the Urbana City Code.
