AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, after due publication, a public hearing was held on the 6th day of July, 1978, and continued until August 10, 1978, concerning the Petition filed in Plan Commission Case #1042;

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has recommended approval of the request that a conditional use permit be issued to allow and permit construction of an accessory building exceeding the maximum size established for such building by the Department of Community Development Services on the premises described below be granted, subject, however, to the conditions set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. A conditional use permit for the construction of an accessory building exceeding the maximum size established for such buildings by the Department of Community Development Services of the City of Urbana, Illinois, on the following described property is approved subject to the conditions set forth in section (2) hereof:

> Part of Lot Three (3) of the Subdivision of part of the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Nine, Township 19 North, Range Nine East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 1910 East Main Street, Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. The conditional use permit herein granted is subject to the following conditions and limitations:

- The building permit application shall be accompanied by a sketch plot plan showing the following:
 - the exact location of the structure in (1)the lot,
 - (2)the distance of the structure from the petitioner's residence and the immediately adjacent residences, and
 - (3) the access drive between the structure and the public right-of-way servicing the property.

Copies of the plan shall be submitted to the City Engineer for his analysis of the suitability of access to the property and to the Fire Chief for his analysis and recommendations

1817-20 for the necessary fire protection standards. B. No accessory building shall project into the front yard allowed for the principal use of the subject

lot. The side and rear yard requirements of the R-1 district shall be complied with. Erection of the proposed accessory building shall not block or interfere with sunlight to the adjoining residences.

The accessory building permitted hereunder shall be of a height no greater than that which is minimally required for the storage and safe operation of the tallest vehicle anticipated to be using the proposed accessory structure. But, in any event, the height shall be not greater than twenty-five (25) feet.

D. Any exterior lights on the building shall meet with the approval of the City Light Department. Such lighting shall not, in the judgement of the City Light Department, be of such intensity so as to intrude into the neighboring residential yards and shall be shielded appropriately, if required.

E. The petitioner shall submit any other information as may be determined to be necessary by the Department of Community Development Services in the course of the issuance of a building permit.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
