ANNUAL TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

OF THE

CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

FOR THE YEAR

BEGINNING JULY 1, 1978, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1979

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, pursuant to an ordinance previously adopted authorizing the same, did, on the 19th day of June, 1978, said date being before the beginning of the fiscal year of said City commencing on July 1, 1978, and ending on June 30, 1979, adopt the Annual Budget Ordinance for the City for said fiscal year which said ordinance was approved by the Mayor on the 23rd day of June, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code (Ill. Rev. Stats., 1977, Ch. 24, Sections 8-2-9.1 et seq.) and a home rule ordinance previously adopted authorizing the same, has provided that such passage of the Annual Budget Ordinance by the City Council and approval of the Mayor shall be in lieu of passage of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance otherwise required by the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, did, on the 11th and 17th days of July, and the 21st day of August, 1978, duly adopt Ordinances Amending the Annual Budget Ordinance of said City for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978, which said Ordinances were duly approved by the Mayor in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the total maximum amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes, except for the appropriations of the Urbana Free Library Fund, which are legally made to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana, is hereby ascertained to be the sum of One Million, Two Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$1,272,391.00).

Section 2. That the sum of One Million, Two Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$1,272,391.00), being the total of budgeted appropriations heretofore legally made which are to

be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana, Illinois, for all corporate purposes of said City of Urbana, Illinois, including the purposes of providing for a General Corporate Fund, a Capital Improvement Fund, a Bond and Interest Fund, a Police Pension Fund, a Firemen's Pension Fund, and an Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, but excepting the Urbana Free Library Fund, the levy for which Library Fund is made in a separate ordinance, as all such funds are appropriated by the above described Annual Budget Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as subsequently heretofore legally amended, be and the same is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property in the City of Urbana, Illinois, subject to taxation for the current year. The specific amounts as levied for the various funds heretofore named are separately included herein by being placed in separate columns under the heading "To Be Raised by Tax Levy" which appears over the same, the tax so levied being for the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana and for the said budgeted appropriation to be collected from said tax levy, the total of which has been ascertained as aforesaid and being as follows:

Section 3. This Annual Tax Levy Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Illinois Municipal Code, provided, however, that any tax rate limitation or any other substantive limitations as to tax levies in the Illinois Municipal Code in conflict with this ordinance shall not be applicable to this ordinance pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

Section 4. That there is hereby certified to the County Clerk of Champaign County, Illinois, the several sums aforesaid, constituting said total maximum amount exclusive of the separate levy for the Urbana Free Library Fund and the said total maximum amount of One Million, Two Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand, Three Hundred Ninety-One Dollars (\$1,272,391.00), which said total amount the City of Urbana requires to be raised by taxation for the current fiscal year of the City, and the City Clerk of the City of Urbana is hereby ordered and directed to file with the County Clerk of Champaign County on or before the time required by law, a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 5. If any provisions of this ordinance or the application of such provision to any circumstance is held invalid for any reason whatsoever, the remainder of this ordinance or the application of the provision to other circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately on and after its passage and approval.

Section 7. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 5t/ day of
