ORDINANCE NO. 7879-37

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Sections 16.18, 16.19 and 16.20 of Chapter 16, entitled "Intoxicating Liquor" are hereby repealed, and the following language shall be enacted in place of these sections:

Sec. 16.18. Minor prohibited from public areas of Class A establishments.

It shall be unlawful for any licensee of a Class A license to permit any person under the age of 18 to frequent or remain in any area within the licensee's place of business which is open to the general public; provided this section shall not apply to hotels, restaurants, clubs, or bowling alleys, and provided that when an area is open, but not open to the general public, the licensee shall furnish prior written notice of such time, date and place to the liquor commissioner.

Sec. 16.19. Unlawful for minors to purchase liquor.

It shall be unlawful for any person to purchase or obtain any alcoholic liquor in any place where alcoholic liquors are sold in the city, if such person is not legally entitled to purchase or obtain such alcoholic liquor under Urbana City Ordinances.

Sec. 16.20. Unlawful for minors to attempt to purchase, or misrepresent age.

It shall be unlawful for any person who is not entitled to do so under the Urbana City Ordinances to attempt to purchase alcoholic liquors or to misrepresent his or her age for the purpose of purchasing or receiving liquor.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
