

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF
THE URBANA CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR
THE DISPOSITION OF IMPOUNDED CATS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 5, entitled "Animals and Fowl",
of the Urbana City Code, as amended, be and the same is hereby
further amended by adding to that chapter a new Article III, to be
entitled, "Cats", together with new Sections 5.15, to be entitled,
"Cats subject to impoundment", and 5.16, to be entitled, "Disposition
of impounded cats", thereunder, which said new sections shall
provide as follows:

Section 5.15 Cats subject to impoundment

Any cat which is found to wander from place to
place, to rove at large, is lost, or otherwise deemed
a stray, may be impounded. Additionally, when any
cat has bitten a person other than the owner, is
believed to be a source of rabies or other infectious
diseases, is otherwise diseased, or presents a hazard
to public health, then such cat is also subject to
being impounded.

Section 5.16 Disposition of impounded cats

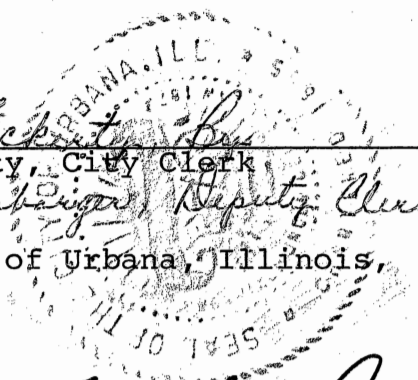
Any cat impounded as provided in this Chapter may,
to the extent permitted by the laws or regulations of
this state and of the local public health district, be
redeemed by the owner or keeper of such cat upon
payment of two dollars (\$2.00) per day to the pound
for the care and feeding of such cat for each day or
part of a day that it has been impounded. Any cat
impounded as provided in this Chapter not redeemed
within seven (7) days after being impounded may be
disposed of in a manner consistent with the laws of
this state.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the
affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority

of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at
a regular meeting of said Council on the 11th day of July,
1978.
