ORDINANCE NO. 7879-42

AN ORDINANCE REDISTRICTING THE WARDS OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, desires to provide to all of its citizens as nearly an equal vote with all other voters as may be practicable and to secure to each citizen the equal protection of the laws; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has now reestablished ward boundaries in an attempt to create wards which are compact, contiguous and as homogeneous as practicable and which follow, to the extent consistent therewith, existing precinct boundaries as heretofore established by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the ward boundaries for each of the seven (7) wards of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as previously established by Ordinance No. 7273-51, which was passed on the 20th day of November, 1972, and approved on the 4th day of December, 1972, and as subsequently amended, be and the same are hereby repealed upon the taking of effect of this ordinance.

Section 2. That the ward boundaries for each of the seven (7) wards of the City of Urbana, Illinois, as designated and set forth in the document entitled, "Official Ward Map of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois", a copy of which said map is attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference, be and the same are hereby adopted as the ward boundaries for each of the seven (7) wards of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately after its passage and approval as required by law and shall apply to any and all matters pertaining to general elections for city officers preceding this adoption of these new ward boundaries. This ordinance shall not apply, however, to the composition of the present City Council and representation by each of its individual members until after the next general election of city officers, and all acts, resolutions and ordinances of the City Council of the City

of Urbana, which in other respects are in compliance with law, shall be deemed valid during this interim period and until such newly elected city officers have been duly qualified in accordance with law.


