

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7879-49,
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REMEDIES FOR LANDLORDS
AND TENANTS FOR CODE VIOLATIONS OF THE CITY OF URBANA"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Ordinance No. 7879-49, entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Remedies for Landlords and Tenants for Code Violations of the City of Urbana", which said Ordinance was passed on the 6th day of November, 1978, and, upon reconsideration following a mayoral veto, again passed by two-thirds of the aldermen/alderwomen then holding office on the 20th day of November, 1978, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following additional section:


Section 12. Study and Report.

The Committee on Legislation, or if such committee is no longer a standing committee of this City Council, some other designated committee of this City Council, shall conduct a study of the operation of this Ordinance. Such a study shall be undertaken no later than thirty (30) months from the date upon which this Ordinance originally became effective. The results of this study shall be summarized in a report, which shall be prepared and submitted by the committee to the City Council as a whole within sixty (60) days following the commencement of the study. Among any other findings deemed pertinent by the committee, this report should also minimally include recommendations with respect to any legislative proposals considered by the committee to be necessary as the result of such study.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 19th day of February, 1979.
