

ORDINANCE NO. 7879-82

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.46,
ENTITLED, "RATES OF FARE - GENERALLY",
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 31.46, entitled, "Rates of Fare - Generally", of Article IV, entitled, "Meters and Fares", of Chapter 31, entitled, "Taxicabs", of the Urbana City Code be and the same is hereby amended to now provide as follows:

The fare and charges for taxicab service for one passenger shall not exceed one dollar (\$1.00) for the first one-eighth mile or fraction thereof, and twenty (20¢) cents for each additional one-fourth mile or fraction thereof; and if more than one passenger is carried on the same trip, there shall be an additional charge of not more than ten (10¢) cents for each such additional passenger who leaves the taxicab prior to or at the time the meter is cleared, provided that on days of University of Illinois home football games, between the hours of 11:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., the fare per person to and from the business district of the City and the University of Illinois Memorial Stadium shall not exceed fifty (50¢) cents. The business districts referred to herein shall be construed to mean the area bounded by Cedar Street (and Cedar Street extended North), University Avenue, Vine Street, and Illinois Street.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 19th day of March, 1979.

The fare and charges for taxicab service for one passenger shall not exceed one dollar (\$1.00) for the first one-eighth mile or fraction thereof, and twenty (20c) cents for each additional one-fourth mile or fraction thereof; and if more than one passenger is carried on the same trip, there shall be an additional charge of not more than ten (10c) cents for each additional passenger who leaves the taxicab prior to or at the time the meter is cleared, provided that on days of University of Illinois home football games, between the hours of 11:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M., the fare per person to and from the business district of the City and the University of Illinois Memorial Stadium shall not exceed fifty (50c) cents. The business districts referred to herein shall be construed to mean the area bounded by Cedar Street (and Cedar Street extended North), University Avenue, Vine Street, and Illinois Street.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
