

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
SALE OF MUNICIPALLY-OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana is the owner of three 12 gauge shotguns which are presently discontinued models and unsafe and unusable; and

WHEREAS, the City Council expressly finds that such shotguns are no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the City of Urbana.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the following described 12 gauge shotguns be and the same are hereby authorized for sale without advertisement to Sgt. Leo E. Ingold, of the Urbana Police Department, for the total amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00):

- 1) Winchester-Model #97, Ser. #E777386 12 Gauge City Inv. #1247
- 2) Winchester-Model #97, Ser. #E778187 12 Gauge City Inv. #1248
- 3) Winchester-Model #97, Ser. #D771869 12 Gauge City Inv. #1249

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the corporate authorities then holding office, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, at a regular meeting of said council held on the 2nd day of April, 1979.
