

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING REFERENDA  
ON QUESTIONS OF PUBLIC POLICY

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the City's best interests to provide that questions of public policy may be placed before the voters of the City by resolution of the Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That any question of public policy may, in addition to the provisions of Section 28-1 of the Illinois Election Code (Ill.Rev.Stats., Ch. 46, Sec. 28-1), also be initiated and submitted to the electors of the City of Urbana by a resolution passed by the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3rds) of the aldermen and alderwomen then holding office.

2. That in all other respects any such submission of questions of public policy to the electors shall be in accordance with The Election Code or other applicable law.

3. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
