

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 12 OF THE URBANA CITY
CODE BY ADOPTING THE BOCA BASIC FIRE
PREVENTION CODE, 1978

WHEREAS, Division 3 of Article 1 of the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended, provides that a municipality is authorized to adopt by reference the provisions of certain published regulations in full, such as a fire prevention code, provided that at least three (3) copies of such published regulations are filed in the office of the clerk of the municipality and there kept available for public use, inspection and examination; and

WHEREAS, three (3) copies of "The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code, 1978", as published and prepared by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., a nationally recognized technical trade and service association, were duly filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Urbana on the 7th day of March, 1978, and there been kept available for public use, inspection and examination, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Ordinance No. 7778-37, which was passed on November 7, 1977, and approved on November 14, 1977, duly adopted a new Chapter 12 of the Urbana City Code adopting by reference the provisions of The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code, 1975, with all amendments and appendices A, B and C thereto, as therein clarified, modified or otherwise amended; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend that Ordinance by now adopting by reference the provisions of The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code, 1978, with all amendments and appendices A, B, and C thereto, as clarified, modified or otherwise amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Chapter 12 of the Urbana City Code, as amended, be and the same is hereby amended in the following respects:

1. That all references to "The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code, 1975," be and the same are hereby amended to "The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code, 1978."

2. That part (1), entitled "Registration", of subsection F, of Section 1, entitled "Adoption of Fire Prevention Code", be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Registration. All underground tanks for the storage of flammable and combustible liquids shall be registered with the fire official in such form and detail as the fire official may prescribe. Said registration shall also be accompanied by a plot plan showing to scale the size, dimension, and location of all such underground storage tanks, all existing structures on the site, distances from lot lines, any existing sewer lines, and any other pertinent plan or drawings required by the fire official for evaluation of the storage.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Sections 1-2-4 and 1-3-3 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 4th day of September, 1979.

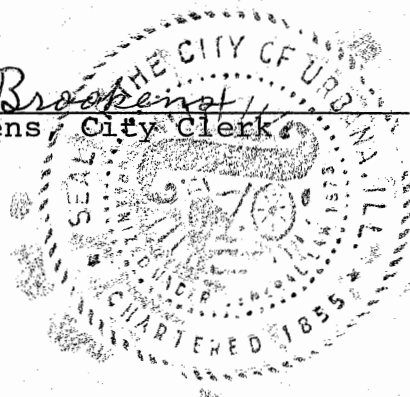
