AN ORDINANCE
LEVYING A TAX FOR
THE URBANA FREE LIBRARY FUND

WHEREAS, Section 3-1 of "An Act in Relation to Free Public Libraries for Cities, Villages, Incorporated Towns and Townships and to Repeal Acts and Parts of Acts Therein Named", approved July 12, 1965, as subsequently amended, (Ill. Rev. Stats., 1977, Ch. 81, Sec. 3-1, hereinafter "Local Library Act") provides that the corporate authorities shall levy a tax for library purposes; and

WHEREAS, in a special election on the 11th day of September, 1976, the voters of the City of Urbana duly approved a proposition wherein the annual library tax for maintenance and operation in the City of Urbana was increased from .23% to .35%; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities now determine to levy a tax for the current fiscal year at the authorized increased rate of .35% as determined by the Board of Directors of the Urbana Free Library.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the total amount of appropriations for the City of Urbana, Illinois Free Library Fund legally made to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana, is hereby ascertained to be Five Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$533,000.00).

Section 2. That the sum of Five Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$533,000.00), being the total appropriations heretofore legally made which are to be collected from the tax levy of the current fiscal year of the City of Urbana for the Urbana Free Library Fund, be and the same is hereby levied upon all of the taxable property in the City of Urbana, Illinois, subject to taxation in the current fiscal year, as such property is equalized and assessed for state and county purposes, said sum is being levied and assessed

for the purpose of maintaining and operating the Urbana Free Library and Reading Room pursuant to the Local Library Act. Said sum herein levied shall not, however, exceed the limit of .35% of the value of all taxable property in the City as duly approved in the special election of September 11, 1976, conducted in all respects pursuant to the Local Library Act. Unless exceeding the maximum limit of .35% as duly so approved by the last special election, the specific amounts as herein levied for the Urbana Free Library Fund are separately included herein by being placed in a separate column under the heading "To Be Raised By Tax Levy" which appears over the same, the total of which has been ascertained as aforesaid for the particular purposes as follows:

Section 3. If any provisions of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any circumstance is held invalid for any reason whatsoever, the remainder of this Ordinance or the application of the provision to other circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately on and after its approval.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 4th day of September, 1979.
