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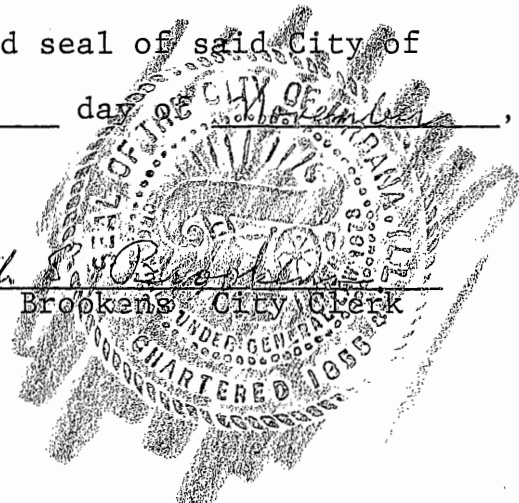

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Edge-Scott Fire Protection District and includes certain Highways within the Urbana Township, and Notice was given to the Trustees of the said Fire Protection District, the Board of Township Trustees, and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said Notices being mailed on October 4, 1979, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 P.M., Monday, October 15, 1979, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois on the 5th day of October, 1979, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and all electors residing therein, of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

Lot 18 in Lincolnwood Third Subdivision, and also the adjoining street right-of-way of Rutledge Drive, being 60.00 feet in width from the North property line to the South property line of said Lot 18; being a part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 1603 S. Rutledge Drive, Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a duly called special meeting of said Council on the 22nd day of October, A.D. 1979.
