

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 16.3 OF
THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 16.3, entitled "Liquor Commissioner", of Chapter 16, entitled "Intoxicating Liquor", of the Urbana City Code, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended to now provide and read as follows:

16.3 Liquor Commissioner.

A. The Mayor of said City shall be the Local Liquor Control Commissioner and shall have such powers and perform such duties as are prescribed by statute and this chapter.

B. In lieu of suspending or revoking a license as prescribed by statute or this chapter, the Local Liquor Control Commissioner may impose a fine, upon the said Commissioner's determination and notice after hearing, that a licensee has violated any provision of "An Act Relating to Alcoholic Liquors", enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, approved January 31, 1934, as amended, or any rule or regulation issued pursuant thereto and in effect for thirty (30) days prior to such violation, or any provision of this chapter or other ordinances of the City of Urbana. The fine imposed under this paragraph may not exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation. Each day that the activity, which gave rise to the original fine, continues is a separate violation.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 7th day of January, 1980.
