

AN ORDINANCE  
REGARDING PROPOSED ANNEXATIONS

WHEREAS, the property described below is surrounded within the meaning of Section 7-1-13 of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council has determined to contemplate the question of whether such property should be annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

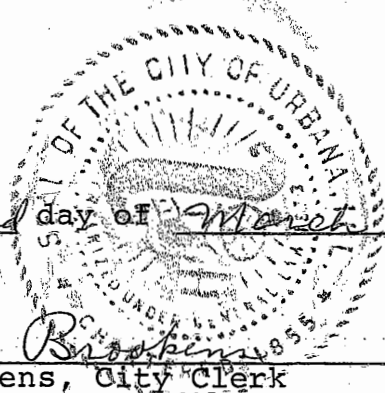
1. That the City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish notice that annexation of the property described below shall be considered by the Urbana City Council at a special meeting on March 24, 1980.

2. That the property for which annexation is contemplated is as follows:

Commencing at a point 30.00 feet South and 41.68 feet West of the Northeast corner of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian; thence Southerly along the West right-of-way line of Lincoln Avenue 794.55 feet; thence S 88° 50' 30" W, 369.50 feet for a true point of beginning; thence S 90° 00' 00" W, 491.84 feet; thence S 0° 45' 53" E, 976.85 feet to the North right-of-way line of F.A. Rt. 39 (I-74); thence N 89° 24' 23" E along said North right-of-way line, 491.80 feet; thence N 0° 45' 53" W, 971.75 feet to the point of beginning, said tract containing 11.00 acres, more or less, being situated in the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known as 2401, 2402, 2404, 2405, 2500, 2504, 2505, 2508, 2509 and 2510 North Shore Drive, Urbana, Illinois.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 3rd day of March, 1980.
