

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 2.3
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE
RELATIVE TO THE DEFERRAL RULE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That subsection (5) of Section 2.3, entitled
"Rules of city council", of Article I, entitled "City Council",
of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration", of the Urbana City Code,
as amended, be and the same is hereby amended to provide as
follows:

"At any meeting of the City Council, upon
the making of and second to a motion to postpone
consideration of any agenda item to the next regular
meeting of the Council, which such agenda item is
then before the City Council for the first time by
motion made and seconded, any such agenda item shall
be automatically deferred for final action thereon
to the next regular meeting of the City Council,
unless upon the making of and second to a subsequent
motion, 3/4ths of those aldermen/alderwomen present
vote to consider such deferred item at a special
meeting to be called and held before the date of
the next regular meeting."

2. That this Ordinance shall become effective
immediately upon its passage and approval.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by a two-thirds (2/3rds)
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of all the members of
the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting
of said Council on the 21st day of April 1980.
