

ORDINANCE NO. 8081-59

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1980, and ending June 30, 1981, has been duly adopted according to law and ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend said budget to provide for expenditure of certain budgeted funds for the specific purposes hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the amendments set forth herein are not such revisions as can be made by the Budget Director under Section 6 of the said Ordinance:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the annual budget ordinance for the fiscal year 1980-1981 heretofore adopted by this Council be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

TO: 045-1-1200-2140  
FROM: Fund Balance  
AMOUNT: \$1,000.00  
FOR: Uniforms and Equipment - two new Police Officers

Section 2. This Amending Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval, and shall not be published.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the corporate authorities then holding office, the "ayes" and "nays" being called at a regular meeting of said council held on the 1st day of December, 19 80.

ORDINANCE NO. 8081-60

AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF VARIOUS AND MISCELLANEOUS  
ITEMS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, owns the following items of personal property formerly used by the Fire Department, to-wit: Fourteen (14) mattresses; and

WHEREAS, such items have been determined to be of no further use to the City of Urbana, Illinois by the Department Head heretofore utilizing such items; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such items are no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the City of Urbana to retain, and further specifically find that such items are of no monetary value to the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the aforesaid items of personal property of the City of Urbana, Illinois be and the same are hereby authorized to be disposed of by granting and delivering such items to the Illinois Fire Service Institute for use in the training exercise of such institute.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of three-fourths of the members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, then holding office at a regular meeting of said council.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and recording as provided by law.
