

ORDINANCE NO. 8081-124

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That subsection (C) of Section 14-4, entitled "Parking time limited on certain streets or public parking lots", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited on Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. Any person who permits a vehicle to be parked longer than the period of time indicated on said sign as provided in subsection A of this section may, within twenty-four (24) hours of the time when the notice required in subsection B of this section was placed upon such vehicle, pay as the penalty for, and in full satisfaction of such violation, the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00), and after seventy-two (72) hours, in like manner the sum of Four Dollars (\$4.00). The failure of such person to make such payment within such seventy-two (72) hours shall render such person subject to the penalties provided in Section 16-1 of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 1st day of June, 1981.
