

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC
ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That subsection (4) of Section 18-1, entitled
"Storage of Inoperable Vehicles", of the Urbana Local Traffic
Ordinance, as amended, is hereby deleted and in its place adopted
the following:

When an inoperable, lost, stolen or unclaimed
motor vehicle or other vehicle comes into the
temporary possession or custody of a person who is
not the owner of the vehicle, such person shall
immediately notify the City of Urbana Police
Department when the vehicle is within the corporate
limits of the City of Urbana. Upon receipt of such
notification, the Chief of Police, the Administrator
of the Community Development Services Department or
the Fire Chief shall authorize a towing service to
remove and take possession of the inoperable, lost,
stolen or unclaimed motor vehicle or other vehicle.
The towing service will safely keep the towed
vehicle and its contents, maintain a record of the
tow until the vehicle is claimed by the owner or any
other person legally entitled to possession thereof,
or until it is disposed of as provided in this
Ordinance.

Section 2. That subsection (5) of Section 18-1, entitled
"Storage of Inoperable Vehicles", of the Urbana Local Traffic
Ordinance, as amended, is hereby deleted and in its place adopted
the following:

When a vehicle's removal from either public or
private property is authorized by order of the Chief
of Police, the Administrator of the Community
Development Services Department or the Fire Chief of
the City of Urbana, the owner of the vehicle will be
responsible for all towing charges. However, nothing
in this Ordinance shall effect a possessory lien for
services of the towing service, if there be any.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and approval.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 1st day of June, 1981.
