

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE
WITH RESPECT TO PENALTIES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 14-10, entitled "Penalty", Section 17-6, entitled "Parking in unmetered spaces in municipal parking lots and metered streets prohibited", and Section 17-16, entitled "Payment of fine for overtime parking at meters", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same are hereby amended to provide as follows:

§ 14-10. Penalty.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of Sections 12, 13 or 14 of this Ordinance may within 72 hours of the time when the notice required in Section 16.4 of this Ordinance was attached to the vehicle settle as the penalty therefor and in full satisfaction therefor the sum of \$5.00, or after 72 hours, in like manner the sum of \$7.00. If settlement is not made within 7 days after the date on which the notice required in Section 16.4 of this Ordinance was attached to the vehicle, the person who violates any of the provisions of this Section 14 shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 16.1 of this Ordinance.

§ 17-6. Parking in unmetered spaces in municipal parking lots and metered streets prohibited.

No person shall park a motor vehicle in an unmetered space in the municipal parking lots or in an unmetered space on any street, or portion thereof, that has been designated as a metered area. Any person who violates the provisions of this Section may within 72 hours of the time when the notice required in Section 17-15 of this Ordinance was attached to the vehicle settle as the penalty therefor and in full satisfaction therefor the sum of \$5.00, and after 72 hours, in like manner the sum of \$7.00.

If settlement is not made within 7 days after the date on which the notice required in Section 17-15 of this Ordinance was attached to the vehicle, the person who violates any of the provisions of this Section shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 16.1 of this Ordinance.

§ 17-16. Payment of fine for overtime parking at meters.

Every person who permits a vehicle to be parked overtime at a parking meter as provided in Section 17-9 of this Ordinance may, within twenty-four (24) hours of the time when the notice required in Section 17-15 of this Ordinance was placed upon such vehicle, pay as the penalty for, and in full satisfaction of such violation, the sum of \$2.00 and within the next seventy-two (72) hours the sum of \$4.00. The failure of such person to make such payment within such seventy-two (72) hours shall render such person subject to the penalties provided in Section 16-1 of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be effective on and after its passage and publication.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 16th day of February, 1981.

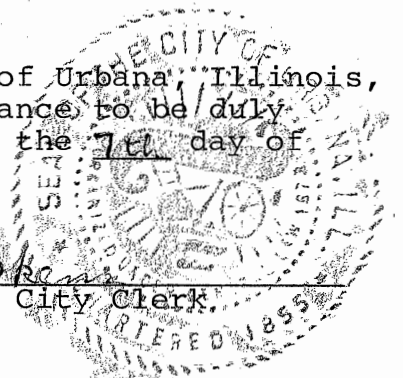

to the vehicle, the person who

Section 14 shall be subject to the
penalties set forth in Section 16.1 of
this Ordinance.

§ 17-16. Payment of fine for overtime
parking at meters.

Every person who permits a vehi-
cle to be parked overtime at a park-
ing meter, as provided in Section 17-9
of this Ordinance may, within
twenty-four (24) hours of the time
when the notice required in Section
17-15 of this Ordinance was placed
upon such vehicle, pay to the penalty
for, and in full satisfaction of such
violation, the sum of \$2.00 and within
the next seventy-two (72) hours the
sum of \$4.00. The failure of such
person to make such payment within
such seventy-two (72) hours shall ren-
der such person subject to the
penalties provided in Section 16-1 of
this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be effective on
and after its passage and publication.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by
the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and
"nays" being called, of a majority of
the members of the Council of the City
of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meet-
ing of said Council on the 16th day of
February, 1981.
