

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTIONS 20-68 AND 20-71 OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby declares it to be the policy of the City of Urbana that the City's remaining brick streets and sidewalks be preserved and maintained as a part of the City's historic heritage and as an important asset to the City's older neighborhoods.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That Section 20-68 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following sentence at the conclusion of that section:

"When an excavation is to be made in any portion of the public right-of-way constructed of brick, the permit shall provide for restoration of the public right-of-way to its original condition by replacement of any removed material with brick."

2. That Section 20-71 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following sentence at the conclusion of that section:

"It shall also be a condition of the aforesaid bond that public right-of-way constructed of brick shall be restored to its original condition to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works."

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 16th day of March 1981.
