

ORDINANCE NO. 8182-8

AN ORDINANCE
NAMING ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 6970-48, the Urbana School District dedicated portions of Lot 6 and 19 for public use as road right-of-way, the said right-of-way being located in the block bounded by Kerr, Berkley and Oakland and Broadway Avenue on the south side of Washington School; and

WHEREAS, the said right-of-way has never been assigned an official name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1. That the aforesaid right-of-way is hereby named Chapin Street.
2. That the City Clerk is directed to furnish certified copies of this Ordinance to the Champaign County Clerk and the United States Postal Service branch office serving the area by certified or registered mail.
3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 3rd day of August, 1981.
