

ORDINANCE NO. 8182-61

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES,
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, BY ADDING
A SECTION PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois,
be and the same is hereby amended by adding to Chapter 2, entitled
"Administration", a section to be numbered 2-118.5, entitled
"Sale of Personal Property", to read as follows:

Sec. 2-118.5. Sale of Personal Property.

The following items of personal property of the
City of Urbana, Illinois may be sold or offered for
sale to any reputable and financially responsible
person by the Department Head of the City Department
utilizing such items of personal property, provided
that such Department Head finds and determines that
such items of personal property are no longer necessary
or useful to, or for the best interests of the City,
and provided further that such Department Head finds
and determines that such items of personal property
cannot otherwise be sold or offered for sale at a
price higher or better than that which might reasonably
be expected to be obtained at the next regular auction
of items of personal property to be conducted by the
City of Urbana, Illinois, pursuant to an ordinance
authorizing the same:

- (a) Fire hose utilized by the Urbana Fire Department.
- (b) Fire hose couplings utilized by the Urbana
Fire Department.
- (c) Individual computer supplies and equipment
valued at \$100.00 or less utilized by the
Urbana Finance Department.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of three-fourths (3/4ths)

of the members of the corporate authorities of the City of Urbana,
Illinois, then holding office.
