ORDINANCE NO. 8182-63

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN ITEM OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, owns the following item of personal property formerly used by the Police Department, to-wit: One 1973 Oldsmobile 98, Identification Number 3V39T3M191293; and

WHEREAS, such item has been determined to be of no further use to the City of Urbana, Illinois by the Department Head heretofore utilizing such item; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such item is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the City of Urbana to retain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the aforesaid item of personal property of the City of Urbana, Illinois be and the same is hereby authorized to be disposed of by granting and delivering such item to the University of Illinois for use by the Police Department of the University of Illinois for law enforcement purposes.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of three-fourths of the Corporate Authorities then holding office at a regular meeting of the City Council.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
