

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 2-115
OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 2-115, entitled "Same—Purchases in excess
of one thousand dollars", of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration",
of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be
and the same is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-115. Same—Purchases in excess of two thousand
five hundred dollars.

All contracts for the purchase of supplies or equipment
requiring an expenditure of a sum in excess of two
thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be
advertised for bids and let to the lowest responsible
bidder, the city council, however, reserving the
right to reject all bids.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the
members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a
regular meeting of said Council on the 15th day of March
1982.
