

AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That subsection (a) of Section 2-2, entitled,  
"Temporary and experimental regulations", of Article II,  
of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and  
the same is hereby amended to provide as follows:

(a) The Chief of Police, by and with  
the approval of the City Traffic Engineer,  
is hereby empowered to make regulations  
necessary to make effective the provisions  
of the traffic ordinances of the City and,  
with notice to the City Council, make and  
enforce temporary or experimental regulations  
to cover special conditions. For the  
purposes of this section, notice to the City  
Council shall be provided by a report by  
the Chief of Police or the City Traffic  
Engineer to the Traffic Commission regarding  
such temporary or experimental regulations  
that have been put into effect and the  
inclusion of such report in the minutes of  
the Traffic Commission. No such temporary  
or experimental regulations shall remain in  
effect for more than ninety (90) days.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative  
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of

the members of the City Council of Urbana, Illinois, at  
a regular meeting of said Council on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of  
June, 1982.
