

ORDINANCE NO. 8283- 92

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES,
CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, TO PROVIDE
FOR THE POSITION OF PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Article III, entitled "Officers", of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended by adding to such article a new Division 5, to be entitled "Public Safety Director", to read as follows:

DIVISION 5. PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR

Sec. 2-72. Office established.

The office of public safety director is hereby established.

Sec. 2-73. Duties.

All of the provisions of law and of this Code relating to the powers and duties of the chief of police, the chief of the fire department, or any other such similar term relating to either such position shall be exercised and performed by the public safety director. For that purpose, whenever the term "chief of police", the term "chief of the fire department", or any other such similar term relating to either such position is used in any law or in this Code, such term shall mean the "public safety director".

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
