ORDINANCE NO. 8384-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited On Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding a new Section 14-11 thereto, to be entitled "Tow Away Zones", and which shall provide as follows:

Those areas or portions of streets described in Schedule XII hereto are hereby found and declared to be places in which the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles would create a potentially hazardous or congested condition or would cause unusual delay to the flow of traffic, and such areas and portions of streets are hereby established as "tow away zones". Provided any such area or portions of streets have been posted with signs indicating the same as a "tow away zone", any vehicle found to be parked in such area or portions of streets may be towed away and impounded at the expense of the owner as provided in Section 18-1 of this ordinance.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the Cotober, 1983.
