

ORDINANCE NO. 8384-45

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL:

Section 1. That the following section of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance is hereby repealed on the effective date of this Ordinance:

"Presumption in Reference to Illegal Parking.

(a) In any prosecution charging a violation of any law or regulation governing the standing or parking of a vehicle, proof that the particular vehicle described in the Complaint was parked in violation of any such law or regulation, together with proof that the Defendant named in the Complaint was at the time of such parking the registered owner of such vehicle, shall constitute in evidence a prima facie presumption that the registered owner of such vehicle was the person who parked or placed such vehicle at the point where, and for the time during which, such violation occurred.

(b) The foregoing stated presumption shall apply only when the procedure, as prescribed in §§16-4 and 16-5, has been followed."

Section 2. That the following is hereby enacted as Section 16-6 of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance:

"Whenever any vehicle shall have been parked in violation of any of the provisions of any ordinance prohibiting or restricting parking, the person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall be prima facie responsible for such violation and subject to the penalty therefor."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 2nd day of April, 1984.

16-4 and 16-5, has been followed."

Section 2. That the following is here-
by enacted as Section 16-6 of the Ur-
bana Local Traffic Ordinance:

"Whenever any vehicle shall
have been parked in violation of
any of the provisions of any ordi-
nance prohibiting or restricting
parking, the person in whose name
such vehicle is registered shall be
prima facie responsible for such vi-
olation and subject to the penalty
therefor."

This Ordinance shall be in full force
and effect from and after its passage
and publication in accordance with the
terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois
Municipal Code.

the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and
"nays" being called of a majority of the
