

ORDINANCE NO. 8485-2

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

SECTION I

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, parking is hereby prohibited at all times at the following locations:

1. On either side of Cunningham Avenue from University Avenue to Perkins Road.

SECTION II

The provisions of this Ordinance prohibiting parking shall not apply to emergency vehicles, while the driver thereof is engaged in the performance of emergency duties, nor shall provisions apply to persons actually engaged in repairing or otherwise improving the street under authority of the Council of the City of Urbana or under the authority of the State of Illinois.

SECTION III

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction, be fined not less than One Dollars (\$1.00) nor more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$ 25.00) for each offense.

SECTION IV

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION V

That the City Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to cause this ordinance to be published as by law prescribed whereafter the same shall be in full force and effect as by law provided.
