

ORDINANCE NO. 8485-49

AN ORDINANCE
EXCUSING THE REQUIREMENT FOR BIDS

WHEREAS, Section 2-115 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, provides that all contracts for the purchase of supplies or equipment requiring an expenditure of a sum in excess of \$2,500.00 shall be advertised for bids and let to the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the necessities of the Light Department of the City of Urbana require the purchase of a particular fifty (50) foot aerial bucket truck which is of a type available only from a single source.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the City Electrician of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase a particular fifty (50) foot aerial bucket truck manufactured by the Teco Corporation of Fort Wayne, Indiana, at a purchase price of not exceeding \$73,533, which such amount has previously been budgeted for the same, without being required to advertise for bids and let such purchase contract to the lowest responsible bidder as required by said Section 2-115 of the Code of Ordinances.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of the council.
