ORDINANCE NO. 8485-54

AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, after due publication, a public hearing was held on January 10, 1985 and continued to January 24, 1985, concerning a proposed amendment to the text of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, in Plan Case #1195-T-84, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has recommended adoption of the following change to the text of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

1. The "Note" at the bottom of Table IX-1, On-Premise Free-standing Signs, is deleted upon the taking effect of this amendatory Ordinance, and the following language is enacted in its place:

"Note: If a sign in the B-2, Highway Commercial, or B-3, General Business, or IN, Industrial, zones are: 1) directed primarily toward the users of an Interstate Highway; 2) within two thousand feet (2000') of the centerline of an interstate highway; and 3) more than five hundred feet (500') from any residential district, school, park, hospital, or nursing home, it may rise only to such a height as to be visible from within one-half (1/2) mile away along the highway, but not to exceed a height of seventy-five feet (75') and an area of one hundred fifty (150) square feet."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the Members of the Council of the
