ORDINANCE NO. 8485-59

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF CITY OFFICERS WHO ARE ELECTED FOR A DEFINITE TERM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Under its powers as a home rule unit, the City of Urbana, Illinois hereby declares that regardless of the provisions of Section 3-13-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code to the contrary, the salaries of elected officials of the City of Urbana may be established at any time prior to the general municipal elections in which voting is held for such offices.

Section 2. That the annual (12 month) salary of each of the following City officers who are to be elected for a definite term beginning in May of 1985, shall be and the same are hereby established for that term of office as follows:

A. Mayor - \$25,000.00;

B. City Clerk - \$20,625.00;

C. Alderman - \$1,800.00;

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the $\frac{444}{100}$ day of \underline{March} , 1985.
