Area per Bedro	Spaces Required
70-119 square feet	.5
120-169 square feet	1.0
170-219 square feet	1.5
220 square feet or great	ater 2.0

NOTE: The intent of Group #2 is to provide parking at a rate of one-half (1/2) space per person. However, in no case shall a dwelling unit have less than one (1) parking space."
