ORDINANCE NO. 8485-72 AN ORDINANCE REDEFINING EXCESSIVE ACCELERATION BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 5-4, entitled "Excessive Acceleration", of Article V of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That Section 16-4, entitled "Motor vehicles", of Chapter 16, entitled "Noise and Vibrations", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby repealed and the following is enacted in its place:

Sec. 16-4. Motor vehicles.

- Excessive standing while running. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor of a motor vehicle of a weight in excess of four (4) tons for a consecutive period longer than two (2) minutes while such vehicle is standing on private property and located within one hundred fifty (150) feet of property zoned and used for residential purposes except where such vehicle is standing within a completely enclosed structure, and except when traffic conditions or weather conditions necessitate such. This subsection shall not apply to buses operated for the transportation of passengers while standing in established bus turnarounds, bus terminals, bus parking lots and bus storage yards.
- Modified muffler. No person shall modify or change the exhaust muffler, intake muffler or any other noise abatement device of a motor vehicle in a manner such that the noise emitted by the motor vehicle is increased above that emitted by the vehicle as originally manufactured. Procedures used to establish compliance with this subsection shall be those used to establish compliance of a new motor vehicle with the requirements of this section.
- (c) Excessive acceleration. No person shall operate a motor vehicle on any highway within the City of Urbana in such a manner as to cause or allow to be emitted squealing, screeching, or other such noise from the tires in contact with the ground because of rapid acceleration or excessive speed around corners or other such reason, except that noise resulting from emergency operation to avoid imminent danger shall be exempt from this provision.
- Any person found guilty of a violation of this section shall be punished by a fine not exceeding two hundred dollars (\$200.00) pursuant to Section 1-10 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That Section 15.60, entitled "Disorderly conduct", of Chapter 15, entitled "Miscellaneous Offenses and Provisions", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following item (8) under (a) of said section:

(8) Does throw or heedlessly cause to be thrown or discharged any stone, dirt, gravel, or other object by the rapid acceleration of a motor vehicle operated by such person on any highway in the City of Urbana.
