ORDINANCE NO. 8485-81

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON THE ERECTION OF SIGNAGE AND THE ISSUANCE OF SIGN PERMITS

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has heretofore, to-wit: On the 19th day of December, 1983, passed Ordinance No. 8384-33 entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing a Moratorium on the Erection of Signage and the Issuance of Sign Permits," and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of December, 1983, the City of Urbana passed Ordinance No. 8384-36, entitled "An Ordinance Amending An Ordinance Establishing a Moratorium on the Erection of Signage and the Issuance of Sign Permits," and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council has now completed its efforts in amending the Comprehensive Urbana Sign Regulations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS that effective immediately Ordinance 8384-33 entitled, "An Ordinance Establishing a Moratorium on the Erection of Signage and the Issuance of Sign Permits," and Ordinance 8384-36 entitled, "An Ordinance Amending An Ordinance Establishing a Moratorium on the Erection of Signage and the Issuance of Sign Permits," are repealed.
