

ORDINANCE NO. 8586-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA ZONING ORDINANCE
TO PROVIDE A DEFINITION FOR AMBULANCE SERVICE AS A USE
AND MEDICAL CARRIER SERVICE AS A USE AND PROVIDING
FOR THE APPROPRIATE ENTRY OF SUCH USES INTO THE USE TABLE
AND PROVIDING PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR SUCH

WHEREAS, after due publication, a public hearing was held on July 18, 1985 and continued to August 8, 1985, concerning a proposed amendment to the text of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, in Plan Case #1208-T-85, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has recommended the adoption of the following changes to the text of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. The Urbana Zoning Ordinance is amended to add the following definitions to Article II, Definitions, Section II-3 Definitions:

Ambulance -- means any motor vehicle that is designed and constructed, equipped, and intended to be used for, and maintained or operated for and used for, the transportation of patients in emergency situations. Such a vehicle must meet the State of Illinois Department of Public Health Licensure requirements.

Medical Carrier -- means any motor vehicle which is specifically designed, constructed or modified and equipped, and is intended to be used for, and is maintained or operated for the non-emergency transportation of persons to or from a hospital, nursing home or the patients home. Such a vehicle must be licensed as a business vehicle as required by the State of Illinois Secretary of State.

Ambulance Service -- means the commercial activity, maintenance, operation or use within the City of Urbana of an ambulance which responds to emergency calls for the transportation of persons who are sick, injured, wounded or otherwise incapacitated or helpless at the time of dispatch of an ambulance. Such a service must meet the State of Illinois Department of Public Health Licensure requirements.

Medical Carrier Service -- means the commercial operation of a medical carrier within the City of Urbana in the transportation by individual coach, by prior appointment of nonambulatory individuals not requiring emergency medical care in transit to or from a hospital, nursing home or the patients home.

Section 2. In Article V, Table V-1, Table of Uses, within the category labeled Principal Uses, the following shall also be listed: Ambulance Service and Medical Carrier Service, each being a separate entry.

Section 3. The table shall also be amended to indicate that Ambulance Service and Medical Carrier Service shall be a permitted use in the following districts: B-2, B-3, B-4 and IN.

Section 4. In Table VIII-1, entitled Parking Requirements by Use, in Subsection 5 thereof, which is entitled "Service Business Uses", the following is inserted as Group #8:

	Number of Spaces
Ambulance Service	.75 for every employee on maximum shift.
Medical Carrier Service	.75 for every employee.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called by a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 19th day of August, 1985.
