## ORDINANCE NO. <u>8586-31</u>

## ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A CERTAIN SIDEWALK ON ROMINE STREET

WHEREAS, certain residents of the area who reside near the public sidewalk described below have petitioned the Urbana City Council to vacate the said sidewalk as public right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council is generally in favor of such vacation of the said sidewalk if such vacation does not impede public access rights and public convenience, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council deems it to be in the public interest to temporarily close the said sidewalk experimentally in order to ascertain what, if any, problems are caused or shall be caused by a permanent vacation of the said sidewalk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL:

1. That the following public sidewalk described as:

The ten foot wide public sidewalk right-of-way located north of and adjacent to Lot 13 of Doctor Ellis 1st Subdivision situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois,

is hereby closed on a temporary basis for a period of ninety (90) days.

2. That the appropriate City personnel are directed to implement this Ordinance by appropriate measures designed to deny public access to the said sidewalk while this Ordinance is in force.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the avest and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 7 th day of October, 1985.
