ORDINANCE NO. 8586-69

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule XII, pursuant to Section 14-11, entitled "Tow-Away Zones", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited On Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to that schedule the following portions of streets which shall be established as tow-away zones:

Street From To Side of Street

Mathews 260 feet to 323 feet south of East centerline of Green Street

Section 2. That, pursuant to Section 17-1, entitled "Authority to establish parking meter zones", of Article XVII, entitled "Parking Meters", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, the Mayor be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to establish a parking meter zone upon the following portion of such street:

Street From To Side of Street

Goodwin 123 feet to 160 feet south of East centerline of Oregon Avenue

Section 3. That, pursuant to Section 13-1, entitled "City Traffic Engineer to Designate Curb Loading Zones", of Article XIII, entitled "Stopping for Loading or Unloading Only", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, the City Traffic Engineer be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to designate a one-hour curb loading zone upon the following portion of such street:

Street From To Side of Street

Goodwin 103 feet to 123 feet south of East centerline of Oregon Avenue

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
