

ORDINANCE NO. 8687-22

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule V, of Section 7-2, entitled "One-Way Streets and Alleys", of Article VII of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by deleting from that schedule the following portions of an alley where vehicular traffic shall move only in the indicated direction:

<u>Name of Street/Alley</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Direction of Traffic</u>
Goose	Race	Broadway	Westbound

Section 2. That Schedule VII, entitled "Stop Signs Pursuant to Section 8-3", of Section 8-3, of Article VIII of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to that schedule the following intersections where drivers of vehicles shall be required to stop before entering the intersections:

Vawter Street Northbound at Harding Drive
Rutledge Drive Northbound at Vermont Avenue

Section 3. That, pursuant to Section 17-1, entitled "Authority to establish parking meter zones", of Article XVII, entitled "Parking Meters", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, the Mayor be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to establish a parking meter zone upon the following portion of such street:

<u>Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Side of Street</u>
Lynn	40 feet to 80 feet south of Main Street curb		East

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting.
