ORDINANCE NO. 8687-26

AN ORDINANCE EXCUSING THE REQUIREMENT FOR BIDS

WHEREAS, Section 2-115 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, provides that all contracts for the purchase of supplies or equipment requiring an expenditure of a sum in excess of \$2,500.00 shall be advertised for bids and let to the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the necessities of the Public Works Department of the City of Urbana requires the purchase of a waste wood tub grinder and a used track loader without following the bidding requirement of such Section 2-115.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the Director of Public Works of the City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase:

- 1) a waste wood tub grinder from Fuel Harvesters Equipment, Inc. of Grass Valley, California at a purchase price of not to exceed \$105,000, which such amount has been previously budgeted for the same; and
- 2) a used track loader from a vendor thereof at a purchase price of not to exceed \$28,000, which such amount has been previously budgeted for the same;

each such purchase to be without the requirement to advertise for bids and let such purchase contract to the lowest responsible bidder as required by said Section 2-115 of the Code of Ordinances.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative () vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
